The overall project, overseen by Oman's Supreme Committee for Town Planning, involves building a four-lane dual carriageway running parallel to the Gulf of Oman coast from Naseem Garden to Khatmat Malaha on the country's border with the UAE.

The first section on project called Batinah Coastal Road – Phase 1 involves building a 59.5km road from Naseem roundabout to Sayyid Said bin Sultan Naval Base at Wudam al Sahel in the Wilayat of Musannah. Work includes building 85km of service roads and 15km of link roads, with construction of 5 interchanges.

In handover stage of the project, Freyssinet was appointed by contractor to perform pot bearing replacement activity followed by: initial inspection, design verification, equipment selection and bridge jacking works. Full activity on site was completed during weekend, without any interruption of the traffic, respecting project QSE requirements.
